

# PCYC – 2008 Sailing Instructions MILLENNIUM RACE

Awarded annually to the PCYC monohull sailboat that has the best elapsed time between PCYC and Toronto (either direction).

## Definitions:

1. **PCYC Start / Finish Line:** The extension of the west side of the west coal pier. You must pass within 100 yards of the end of the pier.
2. **Dufferin Bell Buoy Start / Finish Line:** The extension of a line drawn from the geodesic dome at Ontario Place through the Dufferin Bell Buoy (a red and white fairway buoy marking the entrance to the western gap of Toronto harbour. It carries a white navigation light displaying Morse code "A" with a period of 6 seconds. It appears on most charts as navigation marker "T" and is located at approximately N43° 37.26' W79° 25.18'.) You must pass within 100 yards of the buoy.
3. **Boat:** Must be owned by a member who is eligible for a mooring for that boat, and must be Skipped and Helmed (for the majority of the run) by a Junior, Intermediate, Associate or Senior Member (or their spouse), but these need not be the owner.

## Times:

The run must be made between May 1<sup>st</sup> and the Monday of Thanksgiving weekend. Submit your time to the Communications Centre: include Boat Name, Skipper, and Date. See Bulletin Board for latest postings.

## Award:

The Millennium Trophy – donated by Peter Rowe – is presented each fall at the Awards Banquet.
