Thomas will be joining Provincial coaches Chris Cowan and Chris Hewson along with contract coach Rob Frost and a team of coaches from Ontario's finest Clubs to help accelerate athlete results in Ontario and at the same time help offer coach mentorship not only at PCYC but across the Province.
